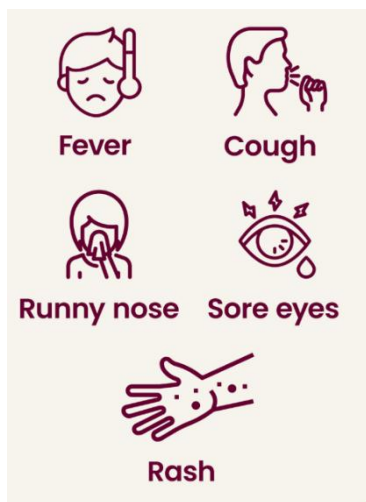


## Community meeting about measles



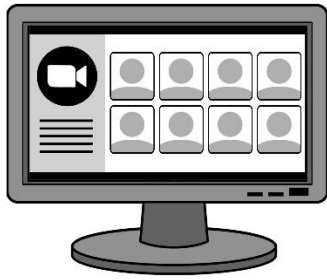
Some people are getting sick with **measles** in the

**Measles** is an illness that can

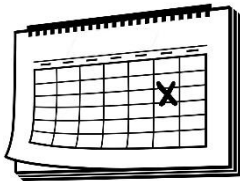
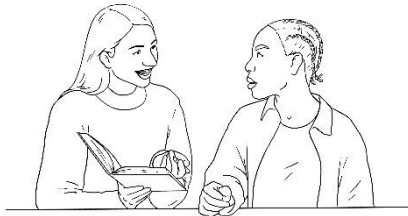
- make you very sick

Everyone is welcome at the meeting.

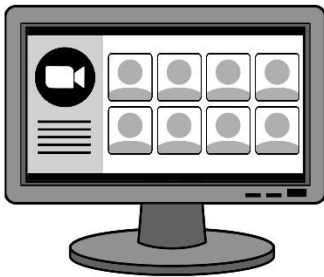


## How do I join the meeting?

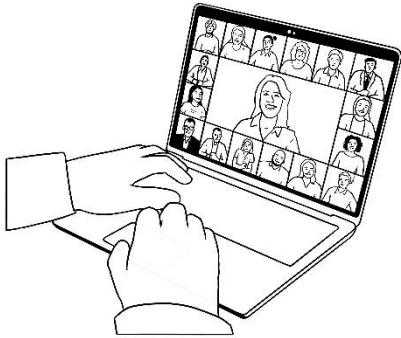

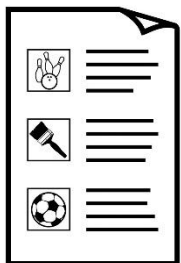
