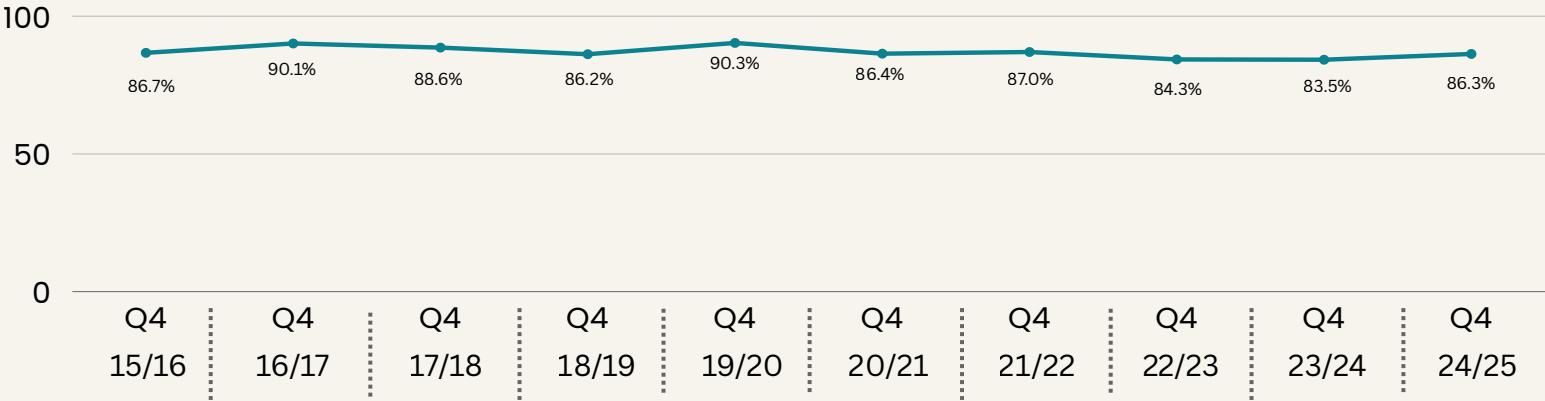


Faster cancer treatment <31 days

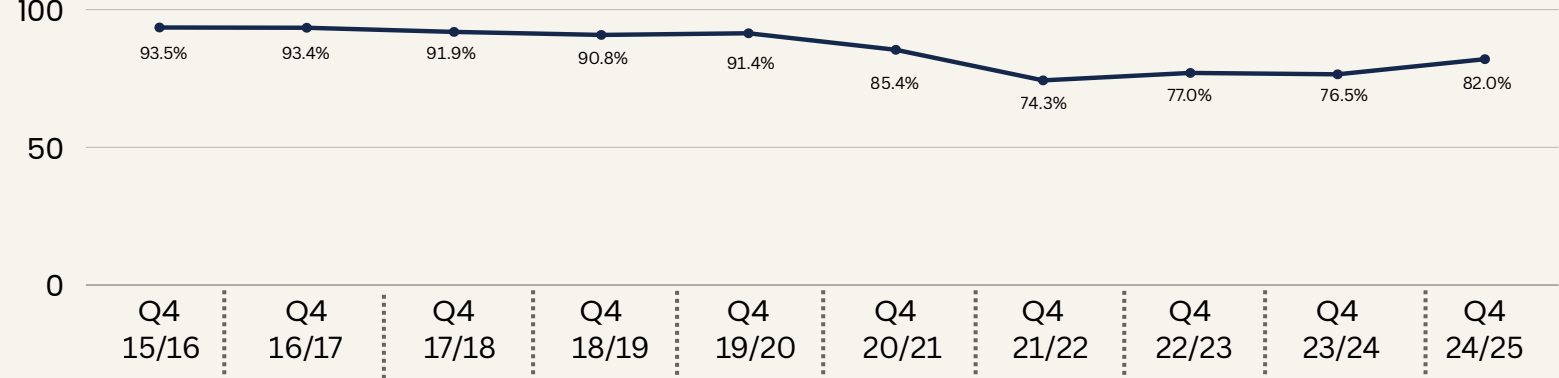


No. of patients receiving 1st treatment Q4 24/25

Improved immunisation for children <24 months

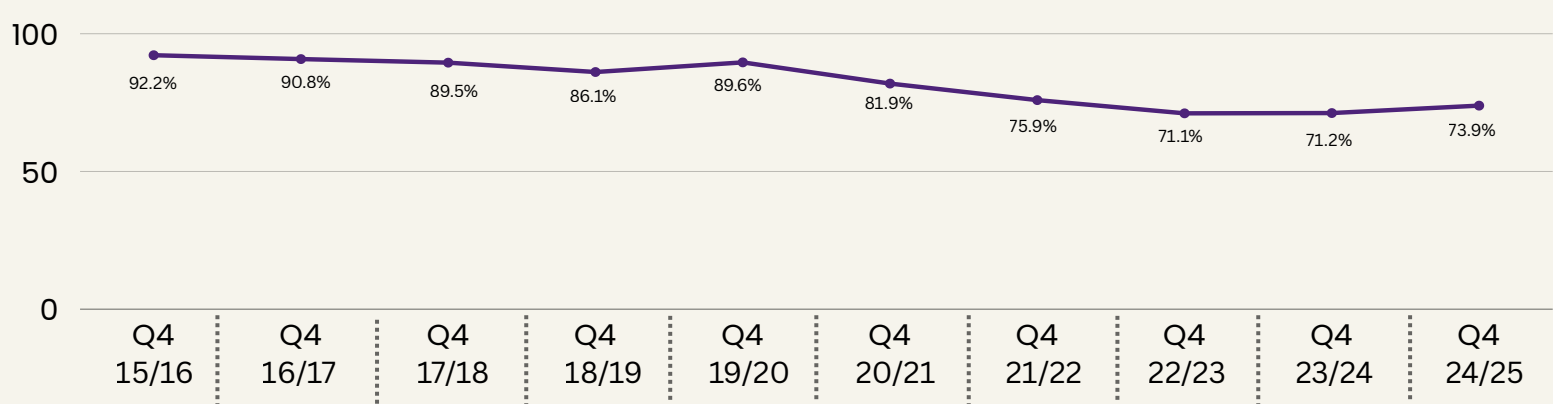


Children immunised in Q4 24/25

Shorter stays in ED

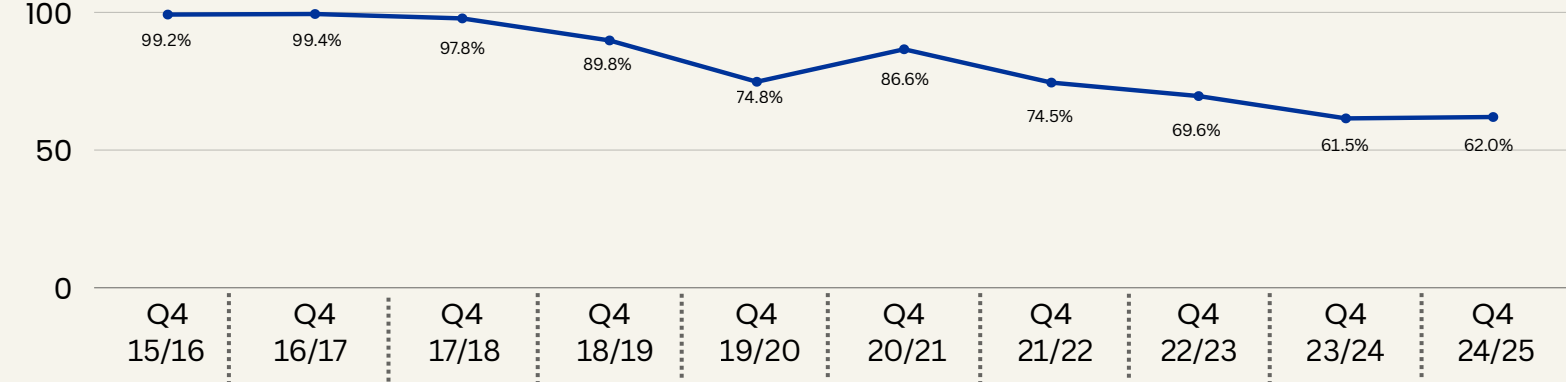


Seen within six hours Q4 24/25

Shorter wait times for FSA

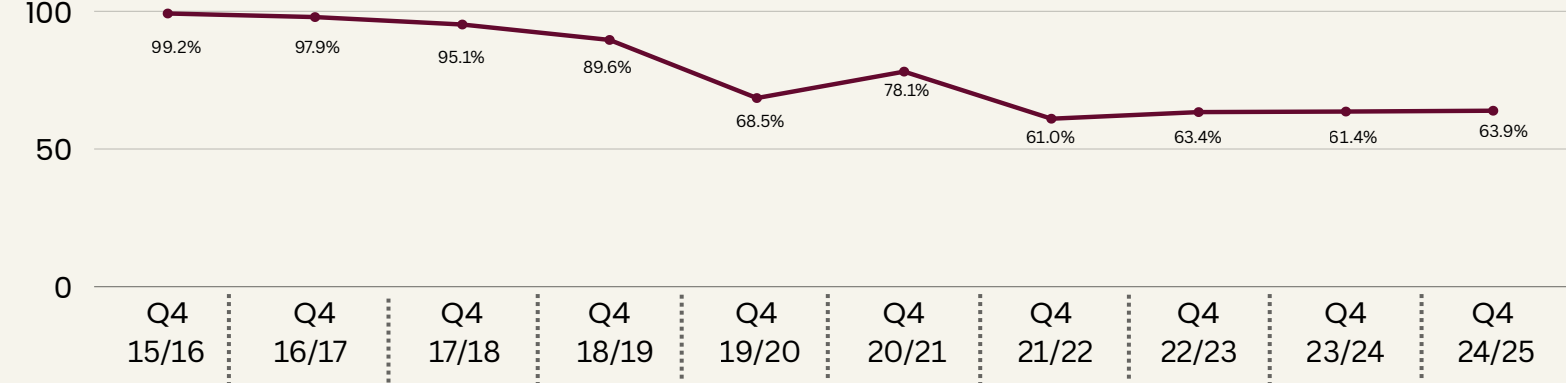


People waiting < 4 months Q4 24/25
