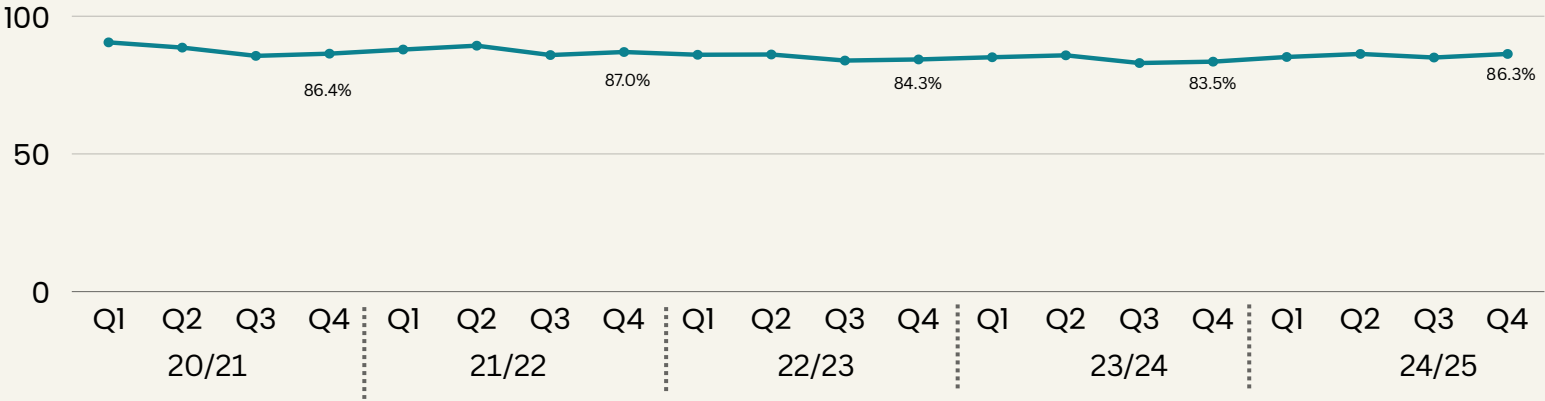


Faster cancer treatment <31 days



Target: 90% of patients to receive cancer treatment within 31 days of the decision to treat

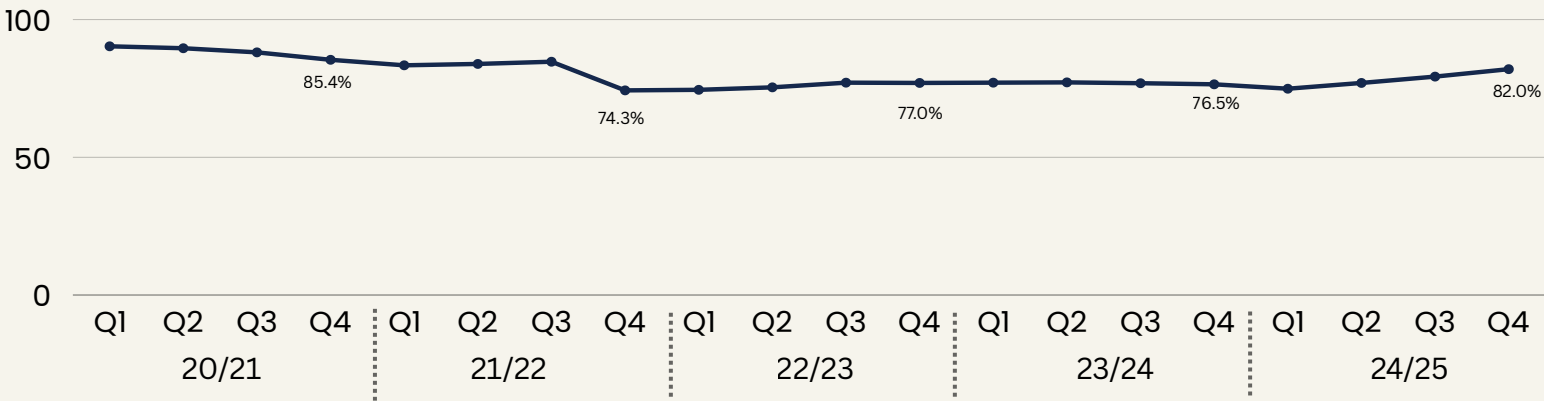
Shorter wait times will mean you and your whānau will be guided through complex cancer pathways to receive treatment sooner.

Improved immunisation for children <24 months



Target: 95% of children fully immunised at 24 months of age

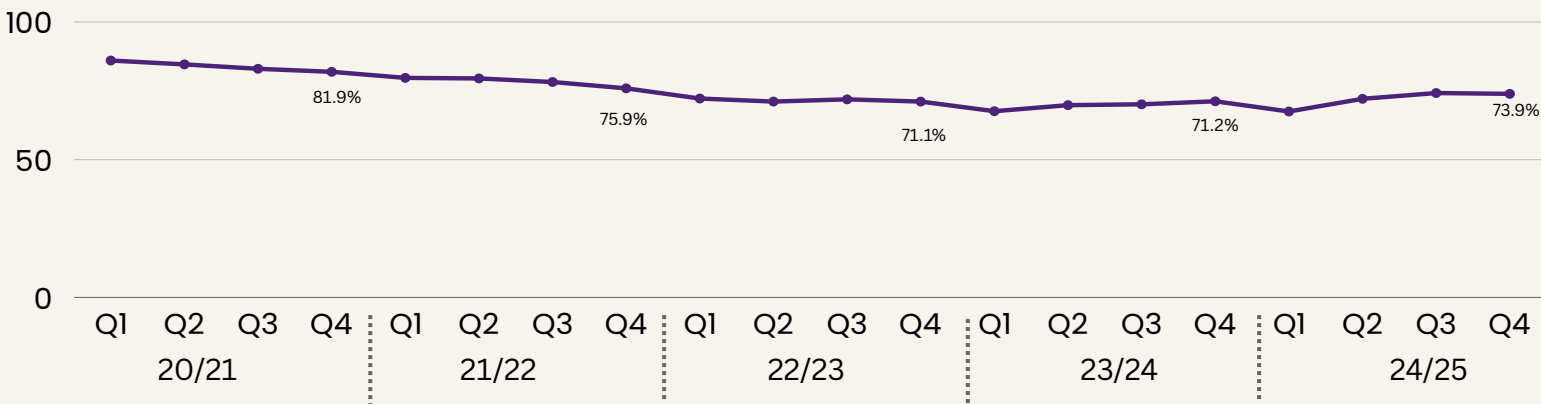
Better immunisation coverage will reduce the risk of measles, pertussis (whooping cough), pneumonia, meningitis and other infectious diseases which can cause harm to children.

Target: 95% of patients to be admitted, discharged or transferred from an ED within 6 hours

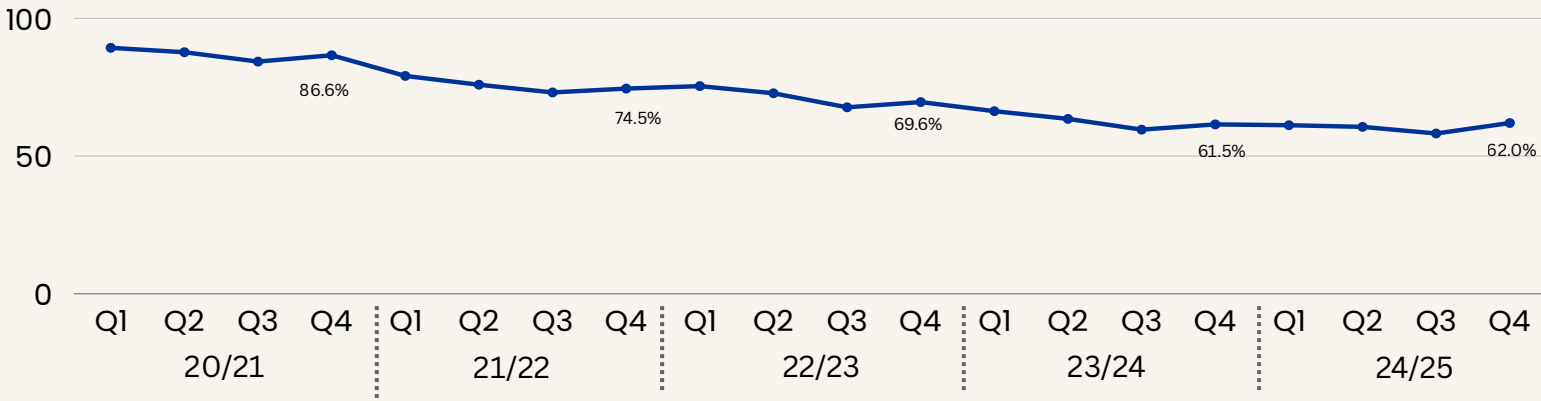
Shorter wait times will mean you receive your diagnosis, treatment, and progress through to a hospital bed (if needed) sooner.

Target: 95% of people wait less than four months for a first specialist assessment

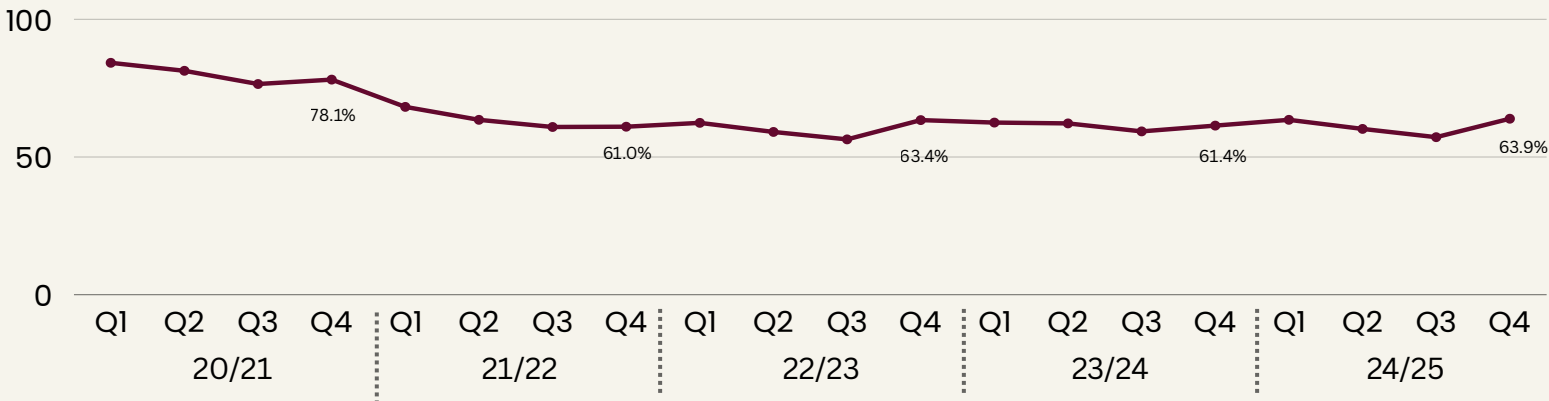
Shorter wait times will mean you are seen by a hospital specialist sooner who will start plans for your condition.
