Simply Stroke for Rehabilitation Teams

6 questions for everyone caring for patients in stroke rehabilitation

1. Are all your stroke patients assessed for rehabilitation?

- All stroke patients should be screened, then assessed and treated as required, for cognitive, sensorimotor and communication difficulties
- Patients should start rehabilitation as soon as they are able
- 2. Do you meet regularly with your inter-disciplinary stroke team?
 - Your team should meet at least weekly, to:
 - o discuss new patients
 - o review patient management and goals
 - o plan for discharge
- 3. Do you have family meetings?
 - The stroke team should meet regularly with the patient and their family/carers to involve them in goal-setting, management and discharge
- 4. Do you ask your patients and their family/carers about their rehabilitation expectations?
 - Every patient and their family/carer should:
 - o have their wishes established and acknowledged
 - o have the opportunity to participate in goal-setting

5. Do you offer all patients and their family/carers educational information?

- All patients and their family/carers should be offered relevant information to meet their needs
 - Information should be in an appropriate language and format
- Follow-up clarification and reinforcement of information should be provided
- 6. Do you make counselling services available to patients and their family/carers?
 - Counselling should be available and can take the form of:
 - active educational counselling
 - o problem-solving counselling
 - o information supplemented by educational counselling
