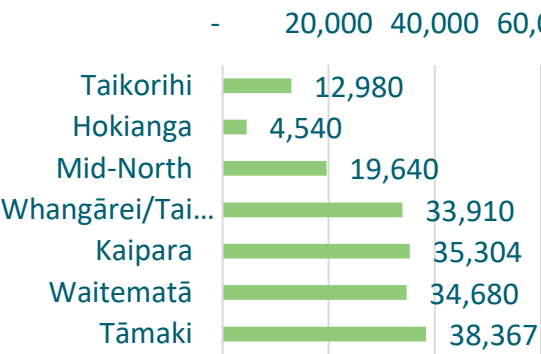

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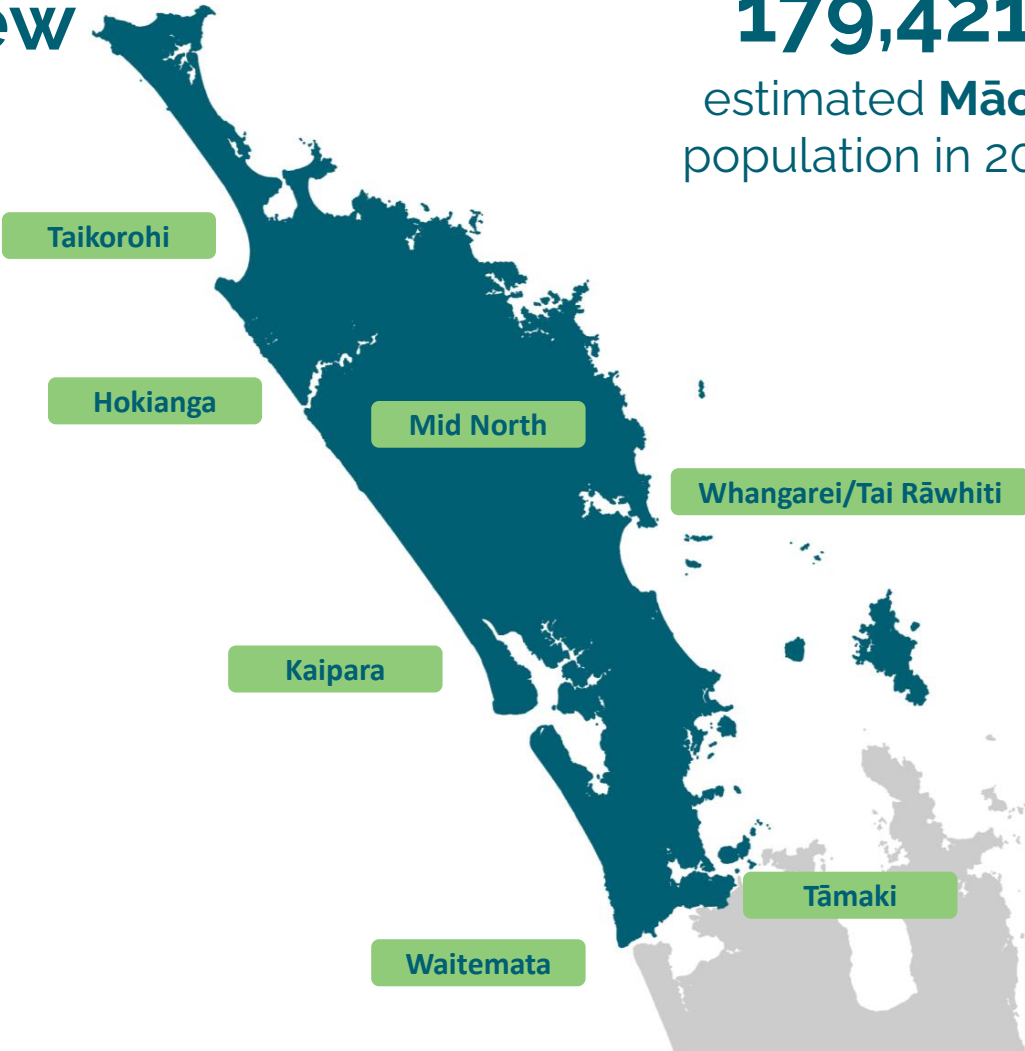


# Population and Localities Overview

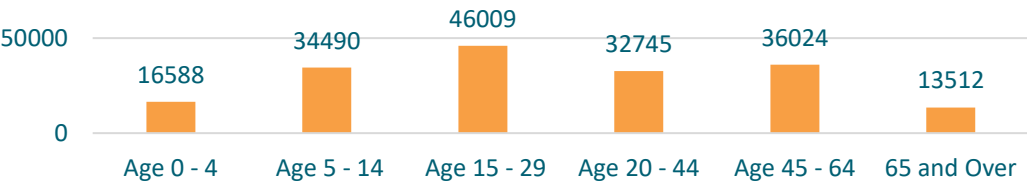
Estimated Locality **Māori** populations in 2022



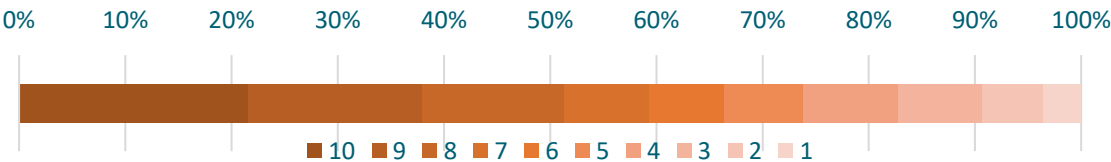

## Age Groups of Māori across Te Taumata Hauora o Te Kahu o Taonui



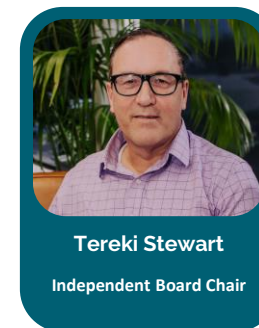
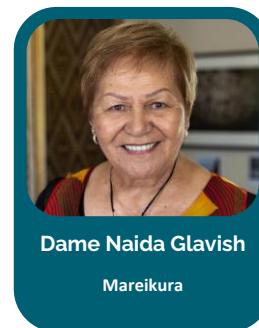
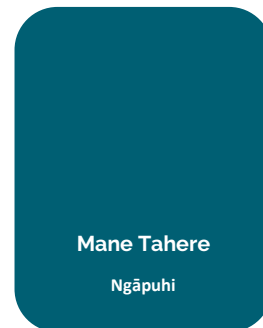
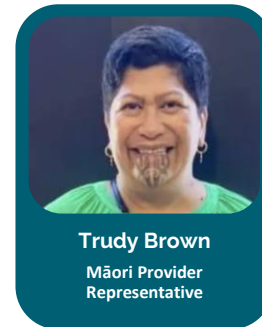
## Socio-Economic Deprivation (NZDep2018)



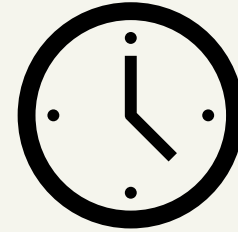

# The Health Information Security Framework (HISF)

The Health Information Security Framework (HISF) supports all health sector organisations to manage and improve the security of the health information you hold.

- **Plan** your cyber security;
- **Identify** and **Protect** your key assets and information
- **Detect** security incidents and know how to **Respond** when they occur.



# Tailored Security Guidance

Last year's refresh (2023) also reorganised HISF to better cater to different types of organisations that can use the framework:

- **Micro to small** organisations up to 25 staff
- **Medium to large** organisations with 25+ staff
- **Hospitals**
- **Suppliers**

**Step 1** - Assess your maturity using the HISF checklist.

**Step 2** - Identify where you need to prioritise improvements.

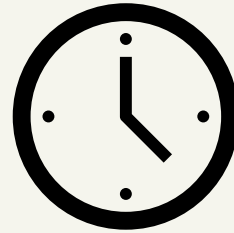
**Step 3** – Set up a project to improve your security posture.

Guidance on Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) and other controls you can implement to better protect against identity attacks



Practical steps for implementing appropriate prevention, detection, and response controls, protecting you against malicious software, and helping you to respond quickly if an attack is taking place



How to manage your business and ICT services continuity planning, so that when an attack does occur, you're able to recover to normal BAU as quickly as possible
