


Understanding your Dashboard




To view the understanding your dashboard page, click on the **Dashboard** tab and click Understanding your dashboard






To view the dashboard, click on the Dashboard tab and click National capacity view






The Dashboard contains eight sections:




- 1. Filter by profession: to view by single or multiple profession(s)
- 2. Filter by Start date / End date: to view by date range
- **3. Planning phase:** this table provides information on whether there is enough health provider capacity to meet education provider indicative demand
- **4.** Liaise and match phase: this table provides information on whether there is remaining health provider capacity as placement requests are being approved by health providers
- **5.** Capacity by geographical area: displays placement demand, capacity, confirmed and remaining in days by geographical area
- **6. Requirements and offers**: this graph displays the information from the planning phase table
- **7. Offers and availability:** this graph displays the information from the Liaise and match table
- 8. Capacity heat map: there are three maps available
 - Planning Days displays whether the number of placements days offered meets the number of placement days required
 - **II. Planning Placements** displays whether the number of placements offered meets the number of placements required
 - III. Liaise and match displays whether there is remaining placement capacity available





Filter by **Profession**


Click on a profession/s to update the details displayed in all other areas of the dashboard to reflect the choice/s made.





Filter by Start and End dates.

Change the start and end dates to update the details displayed in all other areas of the dashboard to reflect the choices made.




- ➤ Click on one of the areas in the **Capacity by geographical area** to focus the details displayed in the bottom half of the dashboard to that geographical area.
- Click on the area again to revert to no selection.



If the information displayed doesn't look right, check the filters for profession and date range

➤ To see more detailed information for a specific area, right click on a geographical area, hover over Drill through, Region drill through will appear, click on **Region drill through**.

All areas of the dashboard will change to display information for that area.




> Click on **show as table** to view the table in focus mode.


All areas of the dashboard will change to display information for the area selected.


➤ Each line in the tables on the bottom half of the dashboard can be clicked, which will update the information in the top half of the dashboard to provide information for that indicative requirement (bottom left) or placement offer detail (bottom right) that was selected.


- Click on the line again to revert to no selection.
- > Click on the back arrow next to the area to go back to the main dashboard.








> To view the **Requirements and offers** graph in focus mode, right click in the graph and select **Show as table**.






To view the **Offers and availability** graph in focus mode, right click in the graph and select **Show as table**.



Capacity heat map

When hovering over a region in the map, a pop-up box will show the information for that region. The region can also be selected in the **Capacity by geographical area** table, which will zoom in on that region in the map (as per page 7).

- \succ Click on the (i) symbol when viewing the different maps to get an overview of what the map is displaying and the colour key.
- Click on the dropdown box above the map to select a map for viewing.




Planning - Days

This map displays whether the number of placement days offered meets the number of placement days required.

Colour key:

Green: days offered is equal to or greater than days required

Amber: days offered is 50-99% of days required **Red:** days offered is less than 50% of days required



Planning - Placements

This map displays whether the number of placements offered meets the number of placements required.

Colour key:

Green: placements offered is equal to or greater than placements required

Amber: placements offered is 50-99% of placements required **Red:** placements offered is less than 50% of placements required



Liaise and match

This map displays whether there is remaining placement capacity available. Colour key:

Green: there is placement capacity available **Red:** there is no remaining placement capacity





Key terms

| Key terms | Definitions |
|------------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Days available | The difference between 'days offered' and 'days taken' |
| Days offered | Represents the total number of placement days contained in placement offer details published by health providers (based off a 4-day week) – multiplied by the maximum number of students health providers can accommodate at any given time within the offer period |
| Days required | Represents the total number of placement days required for student placements, as indicated by education providers |
| Days taken | The total number of placement days requested by education providers and approved by health providers |
| Geographical area | A specific location or region. For the purposes of the tool, New Zealand is divided into 16 regions. |
| Indicative capacity | Represents the difference between 'days required' and 'days offered.' |
| Liaise and match phase | Education providers request placements and health providers confirm or modify requests. |
| Planning phase | Health providers upload future placement offers and education providers outline indicative student placement requirements (based on number of students they expect to enrol). This provides visibility and enables planning across the |
| Profession | year, providers and regions. The area of health the person is training in e.g. physiotherapy. |
