#### Why is regular cervical screening important?

Regular screening is one of the best ways to protect yourself against cervical cancer. You can also check out Screening finds early warning signs before they become cancer - allowing for early detection, follow-up testing, and treatment if needed.

#### How do I get the new test?

Just make an appointment with your hauora provider and they'll talk through the options available for cervical screening, including the new self-test.

#### Who is screening for and where can I go to get screened?

Cervical screening is recommended if you are a wāhine or anyone with a cervix aged between 25 and 69. Places you can get screened include:

- · your usual doctor or nurse at a GP clinic, if you have one
- · Māori, Pacific or women's community health centres
- · outreach services, like marae or mobile units
- · Family Planning clinics
- · sexual health services.

Some healthcare providers may offer a take-home option, talk to them if this is of interest to you.

#### Do I have to pay to do a screening test?

The National Cervical Screening Programme is not fully funded but FREE screening is now available for:

- · wāhine and people with a cervix 30 years and over who have never had a screening test or haven't had a test in the past 5 years
- · Māori and Pacific
- anyone who is a Community Services Card holder
- · anyone requiring follow up testing.
