

WELCOME TO AOTEAROA NEW ZEALAND

As a 2022 Special Ukraine Visa holder, you can access health services just like any New Zealand permanent resident or citizen. This means:

- You are encouraged to enrol with a family doctor (general practice). When you are enrolled your visits are cheaper.
- Hospital services are free in New Zealand.
- If you have an accident in New Zealand that needs healthcare, this will be subsidised under New Zealand's accident insurance, called ACC. You may need to pay a small fee for general practice or community care services, but hospital care is free of charge.

To help you settle into New Zealand, we also have some things just for you:

- You are also eligible for one free health check with a doctor at a general practice or by calling Healthline on 0800 945 375 or 09 306 8739.
- Free interpreting services (in the language of your choice) will be available for the health check.
- The health check will include support to enrol with a general practice, assessment and testing for tuberculosis and recommending any free vaccinations you can have.

The free health check is voluntary, but it is best to have any health conditions (like tuberculosis) diagnosed and treated early, to protect yourself, your family and your community.

Please note if you are found to have any health conditions, this will not affect your current visa.
