Health and risk assessment

- · Mental health assessment.
- · Risk to other children.
- Co-occurrence of IPV.

Other important information

- · Nature of the abuse, neglect or risk.
- The trend $(\downarrow \leftrightarrow \uparrow)$.
- Are there adequate protectors present?
- Child's ability to protect her/himself?
- · Agencies or support networks involved?
- Family engagement with those agencies?
- · History of caregiver abusing children.
- Parent indifferent to child.
- · Social stress, isolation or lack of support.
- Alcohol and/or drug misuse.
- · Untreated mental illness.
 - · Young parents.

Safety planning/referral/follow-up Child being harmed

- Report of concern to CYF (+/- Police) (always complete written ROC).
- · Co-referral to other agencies as indicated.
- · Case conference, multi-agency safety plan.
- · Provide follow-up health care.

Child at risk (but not needing statutory response; **if unsure discuss with CYF**)

Referral options may include:

- · children's teams
- specialist social service/parenting support
- specialist IPV service
- · mental health
- · alcohol and drug
- · Well Child / Tamariki Ora
- · iwi providers.
