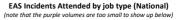

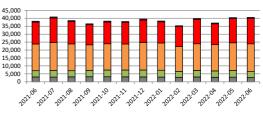
EAS Incidents Attended by Job type (St John): 2021-07 to 2022-06

EAS Incidents Attended by Job type (WFA): 2021-07 to 2022-06





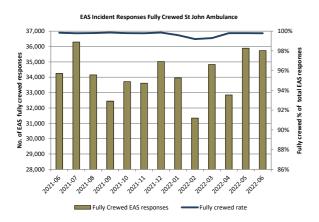


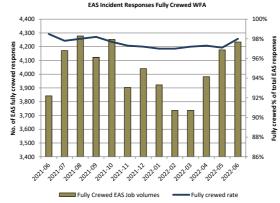


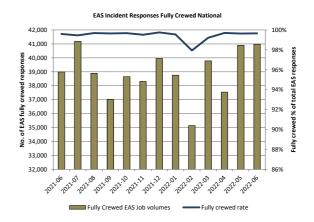

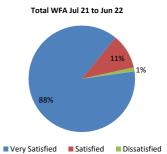

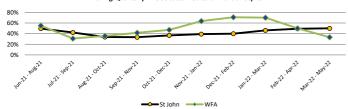
