



Medical Ward Rounds

Whānau/Family Information – Neonatal Services

Medical ward rounds take place every day from 8.30am to about 11.00am for Rooms 1-7 and again in the afternoon from 4.00pm in Rooms 1 and 2 only. On Thursday, the ward round for Rooms 3-7 take place outside the clinical area and is a multidisciplinary meeting. Times may vary according to patient numbers, but your pēpi/baby's nurse could give you an approximate time if you wish to attend. All parents are welcome.

In Rooms 6 and 7 there are cot-side ward rounds on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays. This is an ideal time to speak with a doctor/neonatal nurse practitioner who are available to answer queries and provide brief updates. Arrangements can also be made for more detailed update meetings with your primary consultant.

To ensure confidentiality and privacy parents will be provided with headphones for the duration of the round in individual rooms, or within pods in Room 1.

Nursing handovers occur at 7.00am, 3.00pm, 7.00pm and 11.00pm and if you are present in the unit you will be asked to wear headphones for these handovers as well.
