
There are no Waitaha Canterbury (Canterbury DHB) documents that specifically relate to granting special authority for controlled ADHD medication. Clinicians follow best practice guidelines provided by professional bodies such as the Royal Australian and NZ College of Psychiatrists (RANZCP) and the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence. Please refer to these resources if you are looking for information on treatment of ADHD.
