Te Pae Tata | Interim New Zealand Health Plan

Portfolio **Health**

On 19 October 2022, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee:

- 1 **noted** that under the Pae Ora Act 2022, Te Whatu Ora – Health New Zealand and Te Aka Whai Ora – the Māori Health Authority must jointly develop a New Zealand Health Plan by 1 July 2024;
- 2 **noted** that in advance of the first New Zealand Health Plan, Te Whatu Ora and Te Aka Whai Ora have developed an interim New Zealand Health Plan setting out priorities and actions until 2024;
- 3 **noted** that the Minister of Health intends to approve the release and publication of Te Pae Tata | Interim New Zealand Health Plan attached under SWC-22-SUB-0177;
- 4 **noted** that the Minister of Health will provide quarterly updates to Cabinet on progress against the priorities and actions in Te Pae Tata and the Statement of Intent;
- 5 **invited** the Minister of Health to report back to Cabinet with a National Services Framework and timeline.
