

Reporting reactions

helps us to monitor the safety of the Pfizer vaccine in Aotearoa New Zealand

Side effects of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine can occur immediately or in the days after your vaccine.

Common reactions may include:

Pain, redness or swelling at or near injection site

Headache and / or body aches

Fatigue / tiredness

Fever / high temperature

Other less common symptoms such as nausea, vomiting, racing heart, trouble breathing or chest pain.
