## Additional Item: Breast Screening Age Extension

Portfolio Health

On 12 February 2024, the Cabinet:

- noted that taking the first steps to extend free breast cancer screening to those aged up to 74 is part of the Government's 100-day plan;
- 2 **noted** that the Minister of Health received advice from Health New Zealand on expanding eligibility to the Breast Screening Aotearoa (BSA) programme in November 2023;
- noted that the Minister of Health intends to make a public announcement in the week of 12 February on the commitment to extend free breast cancer screening to those aged up to 74 as part of the Government's 100-day plan;
- 4 **noted** that funding for this initiative is being sought in Budget 2024 and is therefore subject to the ongoing Budget process;
- 5 **noted** that implementation will involve a staged expansion of operational capacity, resulting in an increase in the number of free mammograms a woman can have from around 13 to 16 screens over their lifetime.
