Nelson Hospital Redevelopment: Detailed Business Case

Portfolio	Health

On 1 April 2025, the Cabinet Expenditure and Regulatory Review Committee:

- noted that in July 2023, the previous government approved the Nelson Hospital Redevelopment Programme Business Case (PBC) preferred option, proposing a large single Acute Services Building and refurbishment of existing buildings, with an estimated cost of \$1.098 billion, later reassessed at \$1.83 billion, across nine projects [SWC-23-MIN-0088];
- noted that a revised PBC is under development, shifting to a staged build approach, reducing costs from \$1.83 billion to \$9(2)(b)(ii), and delivering benefits two years earlier;
- approved in principle, subject to Budget 2025 decisions, the Detailed Business Case, attached as Appendix A under EXP-25-SUB-0030, which aligns with the revised PBC;
- **approved** the preferred option for Project 2 of the Nelson Hospital Redevelopment, at a capital cost of \$ 9(2)(b)(ii) , subject to Budget 2025 funding decisions;
- **noted** that if the Nelson Hospital project proceeds, the Minister of Health will seek approval for:
 - 5.1 a revised PBC in mid-2025 to update and provide detail on Project Three;
 - 5.2 a finalised scope and updated costings for the Detailed Business Case (through a quantity surveyor estimate and Quantitative Risk Analysis based on at least preliminary design) in late-2025; and
